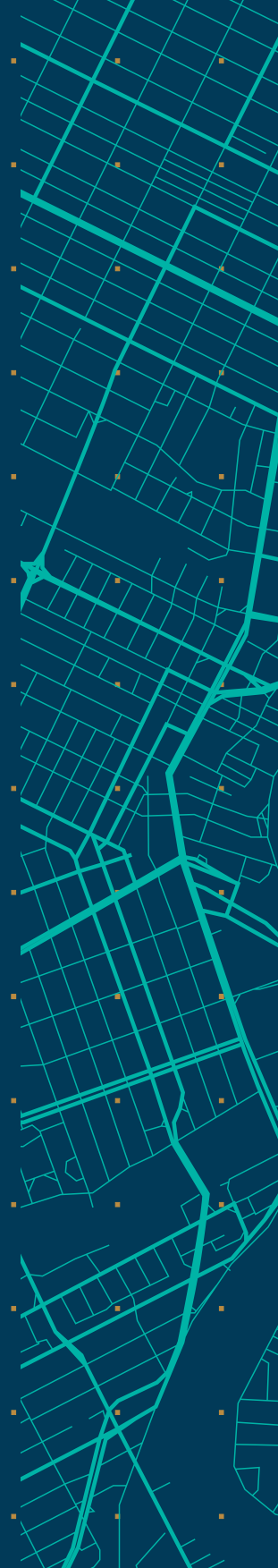

Value: \$500Number of awards = 1

Offered annually to a student entering the third year in a Geomatics Engineering program at a recognized university or the final year of studies in Geomatics Technology at a recognized college or technical institution, who has completed secondary schooling within the Province of Manitoba. The award is based on academic merit as determined in the previous academic year. Should there be no suitable recipient for the award under the previously stated conditions, the award shall be offered to a student who has fulfilled all the previously stated conditions except that of having completed secondary education in the Province of Manitoba.

Deadline for application: Monday of the first full week in December.

Application: To apply for this award please submit a personal resume, along with evidence, satisfactory to the Board of Examiners of the Association of Manitoba Land Surveyors, confirming the preceding criteria have been met.

PETER FIDLER AWARD

The Peter Fidler Award is a distinguished service award presented by the Association of Manitoba Land Surveyors to a person or persons who in the opinion of the Association has exhibited an outstanding contribution to promoting and/or advancing the profession of land surveying in Manitoba.

The award is named in honour of Peter Fidler, one of the province’s earliest pioneers in surveying. Peter worked for the Hudson Bay Company in the early 1800’s and completed a number of surveying and mapping projects throughout the province on the company’s behalf. In 1812, he was sent to the Red River colony as assistant to Lord Selkirk and surveyed lots and supervised building of houses. He travelled extensively throughout his career and made significant contributions to the surveying and mapping heritages of the three prairie provinces.

The award shall take the form of a plaque or framed certificate to be presented to the recipient during the Annual General Meeting of the Manitoba Land Surveyor’s Association whenever possible.

Recipients of the award shall not be restricted to land surveyors. Efforts to

recognize persons outside of the Association are to be encouraged. The award shall be presented, not necessarily annually, nor limited to only one award annually. Nominations for the award, together with a resume of the nominee and reasons for the nomination, shall be solicited from members of the Association each year.

All nominations shall be reviewed by the Nominating Committee of the Association of Manitoba Land Surveyors, which will forward a recommendation to the Executive Council of same for approval at least three months prior to the Annual General Meeting of the Association. Any and all awards shall be presented at the discretion of the Executive Council.
